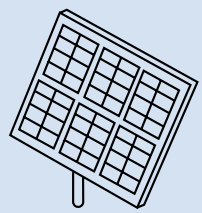
We consulted **>50** UK businesses from across sectors. Including **manufacturing, transport** and the **public sector**.

Here's what they told us:



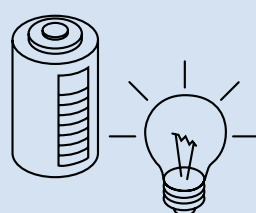
**50%**

have already invested or are planning to invest in on-site generation.



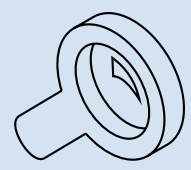
**77%**

**38%**

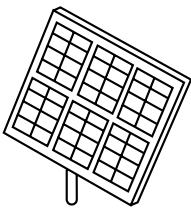
more than a third have invested in combined heat and power systems (CHP).
